

## Community Forum

March 3<sup>rd</sup> 2016

Bill Tilley – MP Benambra - spoke about the rail line to Wodonga and the problems.

Francine Stacey – ASC Progressing Place Coordinator - gave an explanation of the improvements to the CBD and the Playground area. She also gave the expected time frame for finishing each part.

Will Jeremy – ASC Assets Manager – gave a library repair and redevelopment update.

Public questions were about road asphalt dates, boat trailer parking at the lake, new BBQ area and close proximity to the path, the new slide complex and safety, disabled parking lines have faded, the potential problems the new “blister” may cause, new library completion date and the dangerous corner at KV Hwy and Simmonds Ck Rd.

Lachlan Campbell – NECMA – gave an outline of the willow removal and replanting on the West Kiewa, the ideas for the clearing out of the weeds and scrub near the KV Hwy and the West Kiewa and the potential responsible bodies.

Ian Vonarx – DELWP – described the Green Army progress so far and why the willows need removing to free up water for the Murray River System.

Steve Tucker – ASC Environmental Officer – was introduced to the gathering.

Public questions were about Tawonga rabbit situation, lots of weeds on private land, train and bus travel is difficult for disabled passengers, extending the runway seems to have stopped, possibility of a public toilet at Tawonga swimming area, possibility of toilets at Tawonga South near the pondage and insurance of the library roof.
