

Committee meeting, May 14

- **Presentation by Elaine Burridge, Economic and Community Development Manager, Alpine Shire**
Elaine has taken over 2 roles, formerly held by Clayton Neill and Catherine Maxwell.
In the annual budget, \$100,000 has been requested, up from the planned \$60,000. Applications for Community Grants will be opening soon.
Elaine is looking to streamline many of the processes involving the community – facility hiring etc.
Youth Council – Elaine guaranteed that a Shire rep will be presenting to the MBSC students, with a view to encouraging their participation in this council. UKVCA will be included in Youth Awards mailing.
- UKVCA and UKV Lions Club are working together to have 2 interpretive signs, one each at Sullivan's Lookout and Lions Lookout. A local company is being consulted to provide costings and designs for these, to be presented later in the year to both organizations.
- Following a meeting with Heather Green, Alpine Shire will be considering the following:
 - **Aerodrome sign**- *The Embankment Ave sign will be re-installed & trialled on the other side of the road. This sign is already installed*
 - **Bikes in the commercial area particularly around the toilets and the bakery**- *The water fountain and bike racks will be considered for inclusion in the Mt Beauty streetscape. The project scope and overall design works are being undertaken now, with the project currently programmed for construction completion in April 2016. Temporary A frame signs will be considered after the installation of bike racks and drinking fountains, if necessary. Some enforcement via a Council ranger will be pursued as well.*
 - **Community Centre** – *a range of maintenance issues are being investigated and repair works will be undertaken.*
- Progressing Place Project – Alpine Shire has been asked to bring us up to date with changes in these plans.
